1	Trebbiano d'Abruzzo, Arche ~ Italy <i>Super soft, ripe Trebbiano with white pear and apple on the palate. The finish makes a great partner to white fish.</i>	£14.45	1
2	Chardonnay, Las Condes ~ Chile <i>Pale gold in appearance, the wine has a fruity nose with a smokiness and fresh pineapple and banana fruit.</i>	£15.95	2
3	Pinot Grigio, Col di Sotto ~ Veneto Italy <i>A delicious, silky white, with pear, apple and notes of honey and almond. Easy drinking, refreshing yet delicate.</i>	£16.25	2
4	Grenache Blanc, Cuvee Valonnee ~ Vin de Pays d'Oc, France <i>Dry, light and crisp wine from Southern France with crisp green fruit flavours. Apple pear and a touch of citrus on the finish.</i>	£17.35	1
5	Sauvignon Blanc, The Veldt Range ~ South Africa <i>Both the palate and the nose are dominated by rich green fruits, gooseberry, lime and grapefruit.</i>	£17.35	1
6	Viognier, Domaine de Ribaute ~ Vin de Pays d'Oc, France <i>This is refined and elegant wine. Apricots, peaches and even melons combined to make this a memorable glass of wine.</i>	£21.10	2
7	Sauvignon Blanc, Grove Mill ~ Marlborough, New Zealand <i>A very satisfying bouquet with lots of passion fruit, sherbet and tropical fruit. Great intensity of guava, lime and minerality leaving the palate with a very long finish.</i>	£27.60	1
8	Riesling, Joseph Cattin ~ Alsace, France <i>This beauty is bright, with green edges and a developed nose. Complex yet subtle aromas of apple lime and rose petal.</i>	£29.20	2
9	Gavi, La Zerba ~ Piedmont, Italy <i>Pure with a perfumed nose of honeysuckle and pear. This reflects onto the palate and is balanced by some tropical fruit and mineral fresh acidity.</i>	£29.80	1
10	Petit Chablis, Domaine du Colombier ~ Burgundy, France <i>Classic Petit Chablis. The nose is loaded with minerals, citrus, white flower aromas with hints of wet stone. Minerally, tight and racy with cool flavours and perfect balance.</i>	£34.70	2
11	Sancerre Blanc, Le Chatenai ~ Loire, France <i>Carefully crafted in a classic style, dry elegant wine, very well balanced. Fresh grassy aromas followed by citrus fruit, finishing with the pure mineral intensity and zippiness that you'd expect in a classic Sancerre.</i>	£37.90	1

12	Sangiovese Arche ~ Rubicone, Italy <i>Lovely soft, spicy Sangiovese. Dark ruby in colour with herbaceous cherries and violets on the nose and a good medium weight palate.</i>	£14.45	B
13	Merlot, Las Condes ~ Chile <i>An attractive nose with ripe red and black fruits overlaid with herbal quality. On the palate these develop to show ripe plum and prune flavours with a soft, velvety finish.</i>	£15.95	C
14	Nero d'Avola / Shiraz, Il Paradosso ~ Sicily, Italy <i>A full bodied and spicy blend of the indigenous Nero d'Avola grape, and the more familiar dark berried character of Shiraz. Soft, juicy with loads of black fruit and a touch of pepper on the finish.</i>	£16.95	C
15	Grenache, Champs du Moulin ~ Vin de Pays de Vaucluse, France <i>Aromas of red fruit and flavours of blackcurrants & raspberries with soft, supple tannins and a clean finish.</i>	£15.45	C
16	Pinotage, The Veldt Range ~ South Africa <i>This is an early drinking style Pinotage packed with ripe, jammy fruits of the forest flavours. Soft, mellow and velvety smooth – refreshing and medium bodied.</i>	£19.20	D
17	Rioja Vina Amate ~ Spain <i>Vibrant purple colour. Made from 100% Tempranillo grapes. An easy drinking wine with bright fruity notes of black cherry and plum. A good match with Spanish hams and cheeses.</i>	£19.20	C
18	Chianti La Vigna ~ Tuscany, Italy <i>A lovely, simple style of Chianti that really shows off the primary fruit flavours of the Sangiovese grape. Lots of red cherry fruit backed by a gentle structure.</i>	£22.40	B
19	Malbec, Don Cristobal ~ Mendoza, Argentina <i>At sight, it has intense and bright red purplish tones. Fine and elegant aroma with a perfect combination of ripe red fruits and spices, enriched by the use of French oak.</i>	£25.90	E
20	Zinfandel / Shiraz, Roundhill ~ California <i>A brilliant blend of Zinfandel and Shiraz, warm ripe and spicy. Softly rounded with lots of rich berry fruits, finishing with peppery spice.</i>	£25.40	D
21	Château Lagrange Les Tours ~ Bordeaux, France <i>Elegant, medium bodied wine with rich cassis and plum fruit flavours. Complex on the palate with tobacco, chocolate and cigar box notes. Perfect partner to steak and lamb.</i>	£25.90	C
22	Fleurie, Joseph Drouhin ~ Beaujolais, France <i>Fleurie is probably the most famous and delicate of the Beaujolais Crus. It possesses great charm and delicacy, with its luminous raspberry colour, aromas of lilac, violet and gooseberry.</i>	£39.20	B

- 23 **Chateau Cissac Cru Bourgeois, Haut-Medoc 2001, France**
Deep purple red colour with complex bouquet. Elderberry, blackcurrants and other soft fruits are complimented by aromas of toast and touch of tobacco. On the palate the wine is elegant and has a long, lingering finish. The mineral and fruity character of the wine balances the powerful, ripe tannins. An exceptional vintage.

- 24 **Mellowood Zinfandel Rosé ~ California**
Beautiful wine which is packed with summer red fruit flavours. Strawberry, raspberry and watermelon dominate. Just off dry but with balanced acidity to give a clean fresh finish.
- 25 **Cabernet Sauvignon Rose, Las Condes ~ Chile**
Vibrant pink in colour with amazing floral and red berry flavours aromas. Dry and fresh on the palate.
